

## COLLECTIONS FOR AFGHAN REFUGEES HAVE RESUMED!

We are once again able to receive donations and have a plan for delivering items regularly to the Joint Base MDL. However, we have been asked to provide **ONLY CERTAIN ITEMS**.

Here are the items we've been asked to collect now (updated lists will be posted as the base so advises):

1. Children's new or gently used coats.
2. Children's winter footwear
3. Toys and games. **NOTE: No dolls of any kind or items with obvious female form such as Elsa from *Frozen*; no branded toys from movies such as *Batman*. if not brand new, must be sanitizable.**

If anyone has been holding onto such items, we can accept them right away. However, *please do not deliver anything not explicitly requested--we regret we'll have to decline them.*

Donations may be delivered in either of the following ways:

- Donations may be left 24/7/365 on the porch of the Christ Episcopal Church Rectory at 130 Prince Street, Bordentown. The rectory is immediately to the left of the church and is easy to find. The church is a collection point for many charities, so please clearly label your containers "Afghan Refugees."
- Donations may be delivered on Tuesdays and Thursdays between the hours of 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM to our Church Office at 435 Farnsworth Avenue in Bordentown.

We are also ready to resume receiving financial contributions, which can be made in either of two ways:

- Write a check to "First Presbyterian Church-Bordentown" entering "Afghan Refugees" in the memo line, and either mailing it in (435 Farnsworth Avenue, Bordentown, NJ 08505-2004) or dropping it in the mail slot of the Church Office at that address.
