## SERVING COMMUNION BY INTINCTION

- --The three\* servers come to the front of the sanctuary behind the ushers as they bring the offering and sit in the front center pew.
- --The Pastor's liturgy begins the communion service; when the pastor says, "These are the gifts of God for the People of God, come for all is ready", servers come forward.
- --Proceed up the <u>side</u> steps, stand in front of table, and receive the elements -1/2 the loaf of bread or the chalice filled with grape juice.
- --Go down the <u>side</u> steps and stand at the front of the aisle. Pastor and server #1 in piano aisle, servers 2&3 organ aisle.
- --If you are serving the bread, as congregants proceed forward to partake say, "The body of Christ, given for you." or "The blood or Christ, shed for you" (if holding the cup).
- --Watch for people <u>not</u> coming forward (especially our seniors) who may wish to partake. Go with your partner to the pew and ask those if they wish to be served.
- --When all have been served, return to table each time and the Pastor will collect the elements and serve the servers. The last server will then serve the Pastor.
- --When the Pastor is ready to begin the prayer following communion, please part in the middle to either side so the pastor can be seen by the congregation.
- --When the prayer is complete, return to your seats, using the <u>side</u> steps, for the closing hymn.
- --Servers will clean up after communion: wipe communion table and wash the elements and put them away.

<sup>\*</sup>Pastor William will also be a server for communion by intinction.
