

In Person Worship Interest

The Re-Opening Task Force is working on a plan for returning to In-Person Worship Services. We need your help! Please read the following information carefully so you know what to expect and what will be expected of you. Then answer the question below and click the "Submit" button when finished. The following protocols will be in place and strictly adhered to:

- * Re-opening the church for in-person worship services will be dependent on CDC and State guidelines, returning to all virtual if and when necessary for as long as is mandated**

- *Should a congregant test positive for COVID-19 within two days of attending worship they shall report that to the church immediately via phone call to the office. The church will return to virtual worship for two weeks following such report**

- *Windows and doors will remain open; fans and air conditioners will not be turned on**

- * Tables will be set up at entrance doors with disposable masks, hand-sanitizer and offering collection plates**

- * Lysol wipes (or the equivalent) will be available for those who wish to wipe railings, etc.**

- * Masks will be worn and social distancing observed by all throughout the entire service, with only the Pastor and the liturgist removing their masks, if they are comfortable doing so**

- * Bathroom use will be discouraged; bathrooms will be available for emergency use only**

- * There will be two greeters every Sunday, one at each entrance. These greeters will alert congregants of the procedures in place, if necessary, as they enter. Role will be taken by each greeter of all who enter in case contact tracing is needed**

- * Pews will be pre-marked to indicate socially distant seating arrangement; families may sit together**

- * Paper bulletins will be pre-placed in pews; large print bulletins will be available on entrance table**

- * If communion is served, it is done with pre-filled/sealed cups**

- * No singing, no physical passing the peace, no responsive/corporate liturgy; all prayers will be spoken aloud by only the pastor and the liturgist**

- *Children will remain in their pew with their family during Word and Wonder for All Ages**

- * Offering will be collected at entry tables by congregants dropping offering into plate as they enter building**

- * At the end of the service, congregants will be invited to leave by the greeters, beginning with the back row**

and going forward, pew by pew, until all have exited the building

*** Fellowship may be held in the side yard following worship, observing social distancing and wearing masks; there will be no food or drink**

*** Wishing to be welcoming to all, the worship service will continue to be live streamed for those who are unable to join us for in-person worship**

*** Anyone who is sick or has a known exposure to COVID-19 is asked to stay home and join us virtually**
