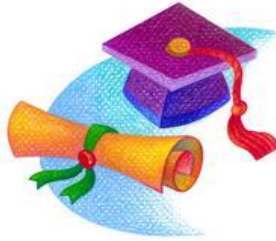

As some of you may be aware, last winter Session commissioned a task force to review our church's finances and personnel. The study was very thorough.

One recommendation of the task force was for Session to invite William Stell to accept an offer as Bordentown's full-time pastor commencing July 01, 2017 for a term of one year. (The one-year term is a Book of Order limitation.)

Session did, indeed, offer William a full-time position. William has accepted! Some minor details remain, such as coordinating the change with Presbytery's Committee on Ministry, but everything is moving smoothly.
